Subject: Upcoming work at 8 Rennie Road

Dear Neighbors,

Dartmouth will be starting construction of the planned expansion of the groundwater pumping remedial system during the next couple of weeks. The expansion will accelerate the removal of 1,4-dioxane from groundwater near Rennie Farm. Construction activities will occur over the next few months and you may see activity along Rennie Road. The work has been carefully planned to minimize the visual changes to the area. As part of this approach we will be utilizing an unused building at 8 Rennie Road to house equipment needed to pump groundwater to the existing treatment system. The existing building at 8 Rennie Road will be renovated including replacement of siding and the roof as part of the work, and the renovation will occur during the first phase of the construction project. We will provide further updates as the project progresses.
